## Bridge Central London Skills Partnership Digital case study: New City Digital

New City College established a dedicated adult training centre at the Hackney campus. New City Digital highlights this centre, which features three IT suites, a student lounge, and a staff room. This facility has attracted more adult learners and increased enrollment compared to previous years. Currently, over 300 learners are using the centre. Seventy-eight adult learners are enrolled, with the majority in Entry-level and Level 1 Essential Digital Skills courses.

New City Digital responded to the growing demand for blended and flexible learning among adult learners seeking to transition into new careers or start ones in the digital sector. A new blended and online course was designed and delivered in the areas with the highest skills gaps: Level 3 Software Development and Level 5 Web Application Development. These courses attracted learners from across the UK, providing opportunities to upskill or reskill.

## **Opportunities for adult learners:**

- Taster workshops and masterclasses to understand employer needs and become familiar with employment trends
- Progression to higher or more desirable courses within the digital directorate
- Employability training for advanced learners to help them excel in interviews and Level 5 courses while boosting their confidence for job applications.
